**MODERATOR MANUAL**

If the moderator module is installed on your system, the following level of users will exist:

- [guest](#)


Each one it will be explained in the following pages and also what can do on the system.

## Super Admin

The super admin can kick anyone, ban anyone, silent ban anyone, set members right to moderators, remove members moderator rights, edit the accounts of the existing users and admins.


The super admin can't edit the accounts of the other super admins.

The super admin will have to login into the admin area and on users listing select the desired user. Click on the user name in order to edit the user profile.

## Admin

The admin can kick, ban and silent ban on Broadcaster, Moderators, Members and Guests, set members right to moderators, remove members moderator rights.


They don't have rights to do actions on Super admin or on other Admin accounts.

The admin will have to login into the admin area and on users listing select the desired user. Click on the user name in order to edit the user profile.

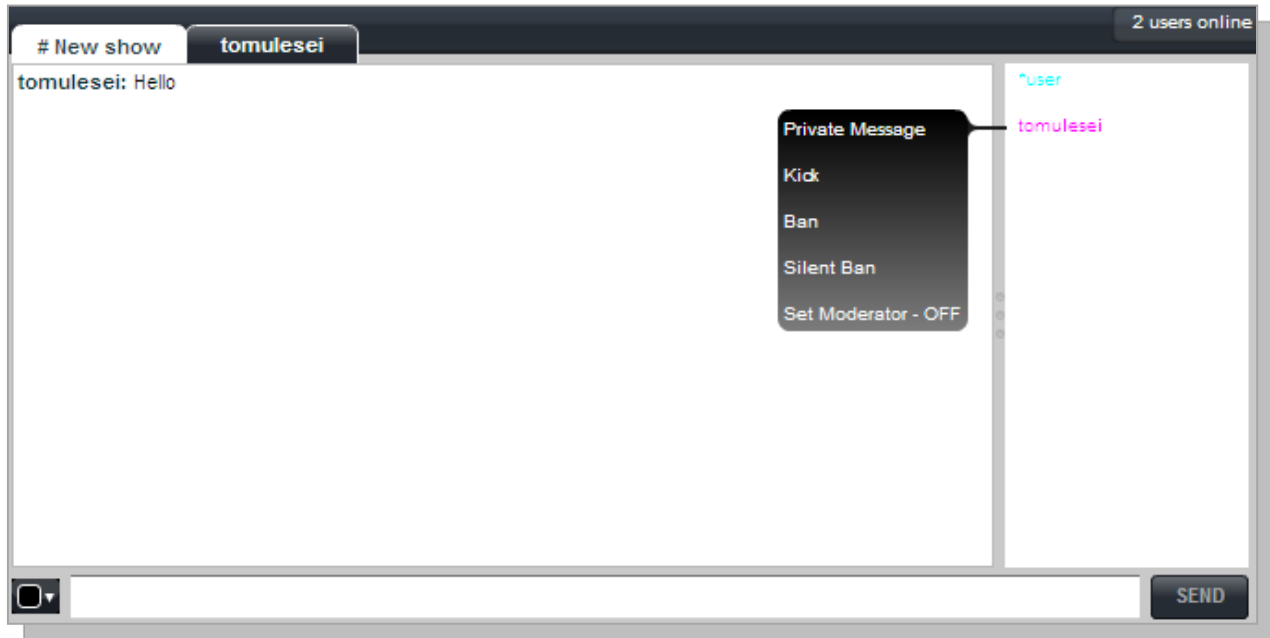
Select the privilege level from the drop-down menu

Select from the drop-down menu the desired privilege level and click on "Save" button.

## Broadcaster

There is only one broadcaster on a show. This user is logged in from the Broadcaster Application. Broadcasters don't have rights to do actions on Super Admin or on Admin.

The broadcaster can: kick, ban and silent ban on Moderators, Members and Guests, set members right to moderators, remove members moderator rights.



In order to view the moderator tools, right-click on a specific user and the list of moderator tools will appear.

## Moderator

There are two types of moderators that can appear on a show page:

1. The broadcaster that login with the same account and connects to his show. He will have moderator rights in the show page, but in the broadcaster player (web or desktop broadcaster) he will have broadcaster rights
2. Members that are set as Moderator by a super admin, admin or broadcaster. This right is hold until any other higher rang removes the right, or the user exit the show (in the case when the user is set as moderator by the show broadcaster).

Moderators don't have rights to do actions on Super Admin, on Admin, on Broadcaster or on other Moderator.



The moderator can: kick, ban and silent ban on Members or Guests in the chat page. In order to view the moderator tools, right-click on a specific user and the list of moderator tools will appear.

## Member

These are users logged in as Member. They can do actions only if a higher rank promotes him to Moderator (the super admin, admin, show broadcaster or moderator). This promotion holds until user stays logged in on that show. Changing from a show to another show loses the ranks.

Once the member leaves a show the rank is lost too.

## Guest

The guest users can't do anything in the chat. If all above users have at least the right to send messages and private chats, a guest can't even write in a private chat like other user.
